Since 1993, congregations Of the Upper Susquehanna Synod have “adopted”, or sponsored, cabins at

Camp Mount Luther. Buildings are adopted by congregations who work together to maintain our facilities.

Currently, all eight Maple Village A-Frames, Pine Lodge and all but one Pine Village cabins are adopted. Camp Mount Luther is looking for individuals, congregations or other groups to adopt other facilities at camp such as, Maple Hall, the A-Center, Oak Cottage, and the Evergreen Center. Some of these other facilities may require more manpower and additional maintenance costs than a single cabin requires.

Show Your Support

Each congregation, group or individual is responsible for cleaning, interior and exterior maintenance and replacement of any small, but necessary items within each facility. Work is typically done at the annual Spring Work Day (held the third Saturday in May) and sometime in the fall. When facilities are in need of extra maintenance, adopters are notified to help share the expense.

It's Your Camp

Any changes to an adopted facility must first be cleared by the Executive Director as we strive to keep each cabin equal in upkeep and appearance. To recognize those who adopt our facilities a plaque is placed at a visible location on the adopted building or buildings.

Synod to feel a sense of ownership of the camp. In doing so, this program helps Camp Mount Luther defray some maintenance costs and allows us to ensure the facilities are in the best condition they can be.
